The meeting was called to order at 10:03 a.m. by Chairman Miller Parnell.

Chairman Parnell introduced Mr. Tony Ball, a potential committee member from the City of Anniston.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Minutes of the CAC meetings from May 17, 2022, were approved on a motion by Mr. Tim Huddleston and seconded by Mr. Bruce Britton. Motion carried.

Chairman Parnell called for discussion of June – August 2022 Administrative Modifications and Resolutions. Ms. Messick explained that there was a list of modifications in the agenda packet to review that were discussed during the months of June, July, and August to keep the members of the CAC up to date. There were five modifications that created changes to the TIP and two modifications that did not create changes to the TIP spreadsheet during these months. Ms. Messick also reported the four resolutions adopted between June and August.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Chairman Parnell called for the Review of FY 20-23 TIP Update and Administrative Modifications. Ms. Messick gave the members a copy of the current TIP. There were five administrative modifications that made changes to the TIP Spreadsheet and no administrative modifications that did not create changes to the spreadsheet.

Chairman Parnell next called for discussion of Status Report of ALDOT projects. Ms. Messick reported the US-431 access management project was working on punch list items and awaiting final acceptance. The I-20 and AL-9 resurfacing projects are working on punch list work and awaiting final acceptance. The 431 resurfacing project is working on shoulder treatment and awaiting permanent stripe. Finally, the I-20 resurfacing from H.J. Bentley Jr. Overpass to Snow Creek had completed micro-milling, awaiting shoulder treatment, and OGFC surfacing would follow.

Chairman Parnell continued by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. Ms. Messick explained that there was a list of previous observations in the agenda packet for review. Ms. Messick explained there were three updates. The first was to item #26 ALDOT will not do a warrant study with projected traffic changes, so this study will wait until after the development is complete and traffic reflects. The second update was to item #28 which had been moved to closed status. The City Council had made the request to eliminate the signal lights at this intersection at the beginning of the year. No changes would be made to the intersection unless the Council agreed to revert to signals. The third update was to item #29 which had also been moved to closed status. A traffic impact study was completed by ALDOT at the behest of the City of Anniston prior to the new Jacks construction. There are 2 access points: full access on Choccolocco Rd and a right in/right out on the bypass.

Chairman Parnell called for discussion of CAC Chair and Vice Chair elections. Mr. Tim Huddleston motioned for Mr. Miller Parnell to remain as the CAC Chair. This motion was seconded by Mr. David West. Motion carried. Mr. Miller Parnell motioned for Mr. Tim Huddleston to remain as CAC Vice Chair. This motion was seconded by Mr. Bruce Britton. Motion carried.

#### **OTHER BUSINESS:**

Chairman Parnell Huddleston called for discussion of CAC vacancies. Anniston has 9 vacancies, Jacksonville has 1, Calhoun County has 2, Oxford has 7, Weaver has 1 vacancy, and 1 for Hobson City.

Next, Chairman Parnell called for the report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. Ms. Messick reported the ADA Paratransit Ridership for Anniston had 523 (increase) one-way trips, Jacksonville had 176 (increase) one-way trips, 35 trips for Weaver (increase), and Oxford had 110 (increase) one-way trips. For the Urbanized area 204 (increase) one-way trips and 126 (increase) one-way trips for the Rural area. Fixed-route ridership had a total of 10,763 (decrease) riders for the month of August.

The next CAC meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, November 16 at 10:00 a.m.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Mr. Rick Robins and seconded by Mr. Tim Huddleston to adjourn. The meeting was adjourned at 10:43 a.m.




