The meeting was called to order at 10:03 a.m. by Ms. Libby Messick.

Upon reviewing the minutes of the September 7, 2022, meeting, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Toby Bennington and was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens.

OLD BUSINESS:

There were no old business items to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Messick called for review of the FY 20-23 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. She gave the members handouts of the list of MPO projects. Ms. Messick explained that there were four administrative modifications for the month that created changes on the TIP spreadsheet and three administrative modifications that did not create changes to the TIP spreadsheet.

Ms. Messick next called for discussion of Status Report of Pre-Construction projects. Mr. Michael Burgh reported for project #30 Reconfigure intersection US-78 and Barry that staking for survey had begun. Mr. Matt Hawes reported that corrected sheets were incoming, and the project is on schedule for Let. Mr. Michael Burgh reported project #41 bridge replacement on Airport Rd at Coldwater creek that a draft had been received. Mr. Matt Hawes reported on projects #48-50 that all were at 30% plans, project #49 a TSandL was waiting, and material reports for #48 and #50 were incoming. Mr. Rodney McCain reported for projects 44 and 55. Installation of the roundabout at Bynum Leatherwood and Old Gadsden Highway, project #44, was submitted for review and is on schedule for January 23 Let. Resurfacing Eulaton Gate Rd, project #55 is starting on preliminary paperwork. Mr. Matt Hawes reported project

#57, resurfacing on George Douthit has completed field survey, would be meeting later the day for preliminary scope, and 30% plans have started.

Ms. Messick next called for discussion of Status Report of ALDOT projects. No report was received from Mr. Shane Brown but should be available by the MPO Policy meeting the following week.

Next, Ms. Messick continued by calling for discussion of Safety Observations. She reported the ADA Paratransit Ridership for Anniston had 587 (increase) one-way trips, Jacksonville had 178 (increase) one-way trips, 55 trips for Weaver (increase), and Oxford had 99 (decrease) one-way trips. For the Urbanized area 161 (decrease) one-way trips and 114 (decrease) one-way trips for the Rural area. Fixed-route ridership had a total of 10,645 (decrease) riders for the month of September.

The next TAC meeting will be Wednesday, November 9, 2022, at 10:00 a.m.

There being no other business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 10:20 a.m with a motion from Mr. Toby Bennington and a second from Mr. Rodney McCain.

WHEREAS, the Calhoun Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration and the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) has reviewed the requirement to adopt Performance Measurement Targets for use in the transportation process as required by 23 CFR 490.105;
