The meeting was called to order at 10:01 a.m. by Ms. Libby Messick.

Upon reviewing the minutes of the November 8, 2023, meeting, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Toby Bennington and was seconded by Mr. Rodney McCain.

OLD BUSINESS:

There were no old business items to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Messick called for a review of the FY 24-27 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. She gave the members handouts of the list of MPO projects. Ms. Messick explained that four administrative modifications created changes to the TIP spreadsheet and five administrative modifications did not create changes to the TIP spreadsheet.

Ms. Messick next called for a discussion of the Status Report of Pre-Construction projects. Mr. Brady Whatley reported Project 48 had the PS&E received and clarification was needed on UT; and Project 49 was pending an environmental coordination meeting.

Ms. Messick next called for a discussion of the Status Report of ALDOT projects. Mr. Shane Brown reported the reconfiguration of the intersection at US 78 and Barry St has utility conflicts and is hoping for a March 4th start, US 431 resurfacing from just north of SR-144 to 0.28 miles south of SR-204 has been accepted for maintenance, and SR-21 resurfacing is awaiting a preconstruction meeting and is hoping to have a start date in March/April.

Next, Ms. Messick continued by calling for a discussion of Safety Observations. She explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at previous meetings for review. Mr. Branton Cole reported an update for item number 6 in which the City of Anniston would submit a formal lighting evaluation request to ALDOT.

Next, Ms. Messick called for the Report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. She reported the ADA Paratransit Ridership for Anniston had 434 (increase) one-way trips, Jacksonville had 139 (decrease) one-way trips, 21 trips for Weaver (increase), and Oxford had 77 (decrease) one-way trips. For the Urbanized area 81 (increase) one-way trips and 32 (decrease) one-way trips for the Rural area. Fixed-route ridership had a total of 6,320 (decrease) riders for the month of December.

The next TAC meeting will be Wednesday, February, at 10:12 a.m.

There being no other business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 10:12 a.m.
