The meeting was called to order at 10:03 a.m. by Ms. Libby Messick.

Upon reviewing the minutes of the January 10, 2024, meeting, a motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Mark Stephens and was seconded by Mr. Toby Bennington.

OLD BUSINESS:

There were no old business items to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS:

Ms. Messick called for a review of the FY 24-27 TIP Spreadsheet and Administrative Modifications. She gave the members handouts of the list of MPO projects. Ms. Messick explained that one administrative modification created changes to the TIP spreadsheet and no administrative modifications did not create changes to the TIP spreadsheet.

Ms. Messick then called for a discussion of Resolution No. 862. Ms. Messick explained this resolution was to certify the FY24 ADA Paratransit Implementation Plan Update. She further explained that this is an annual certification, the TAB solicited public comments and the comment period ended January 9. A motion was made by Mr. Toby Bennington to approve this certification with **Resolution No. 862**, which was seconded by Mr. Mark Stephens. Motion carried.

Ms. Messick next called for a discussion of the Status Report of Pre-Construction projects. There was no representation from PreCon, so no updates were given at this time.

Ms. Messick next called for a discussion of the Status Report of ALDOT projects. Mr. Shane Brown reported the reconfiguration of the intersection at US 78 and Barry St has worked through their utility conflicts and is looking for a March 4th start and SR-21 resurfacing is awaiting a preconstruction meeting and is hoping to have a start date in March/April.

Next, Ms. Messick continued by calling for a discussion of Safety Observations. She explained that there was a handout in the agenda packet with the list of concerns from the CAC that had been discussed at

previous meetings for review. Mr. Toby Bennington confirmed an update for item number 6 in which the City of Anniston had submitted a formal lighting evaluation request to ALDOT. Mr. Mark Smith reported for item number 26 that The City of Jacksonville will submit a request to initiate the warrant study early.

Next, Ms. Messick called for the Report on Urban Fixed Route and ADA Handicapped Transit Systems. She reported TAB information had not been given before the TAC but should have information for next week's MPO meeting.

The next TAC meeting will be Wednesday, March 13, at 10:00 a.m.
